# Baby Henry's Designer Heirloom Afghan Crochet Along {PART 1}



#### Ready, set, go...

Here we go with the first part of Henry's Blanket. This week we will be working the first 13 rounds of the modified center from Mandala N°6.

### Resources

- Incorporated Designs: This blanket incorporates patterns by three amazing designers. They are all beautifully written patterns with great photo tutorials. You will need to purchase "Mandala N°6" by CAROcreated, available on Ravelry or Etsy, and "Dandelion Border-Overlay Crochet" by Lilla Bjorn, also available on Ravelry or Etsy. "Sophie's Garden Squaring" by Dedri Uys is available on her website. To assemble this blanket, you will need these three patterns and the modifications released in this CAL.

## Materials:

You will need yarn, an appropriately sized crochet hook and a tapestry needle for joining. For more details on this see the introduction information.

## **Abbreviations**

| dc   | double crochet            | inc      | increase/increases                   |
| tr   | treble crochet            | st-sc    | knotless standing single crochet     |
| FL   | front loop                | NJ       | needle Join                          |
| FP   | front post                | st(s)    | stitch(es)                           |

## **BEFORE YOU START:**

- 1. If you have not already done so you will need to purchase Mandala N°6" by CAROcreated.
- 2. READ the "Important Notes" section of the Mandala N°6 Pattern on pages 5-7, this contains very useful and important information!
- 3. Note that all single stitches in this pattern should be worked **BACK-LOOP ONLY** unless otherwise noted.

### Instructions

#### Rounds 1-5

Complete rounds 1-5 of Mandala N°6 as written ending round 5 with NJ in 1st sc.

#### Round 6

Change yarn to next color. Fasten on the new yarn into the second sc (BL) after any inc.

\* 1 sc (the first sc of the rd will be a st-sc), FLtr into the FL of the sc in rd 2 directly below, do not sk st in rd 5, 2 sc, FLtr into the FL of the sc in rd 2 directly below, sk st in row 5, 1 sc\* 6 times, NJ in the 1st sc.



(36 stitches)

#### **Round 7**

Change yarn to next color. Fasten on the new yarn to any FLtr (BL) where no stitch was skipped of rd 6.

\* 2 sc (the first sc of the rd will be a st-sc), FLtr2Tog working both FLtr into the FL of the sc in rd 3 most visible in between the FLtr from rd 6, sk 1 st of rd 6, 2 sc, FLtr2Tog working both FLtr into the FL of the sc in rd 3 visible in between the FLtr from rd 6, sk no st, 1 sc \* 6 times, NJ in 1st sc.

(42 stitches)



#### **Round 8**

Change yarn to next color. Fasten on the new yarn to the first st (BL) in any 2 sc group.

\*1 inc (the first sc of the rd will be a st-sc), 6 sc\* 6 times, NJ in 1st SC.

(48 stitches)



#### Round 9

Change yarn to next color. Fasten on the new yarn to the first st (BL) of any inc of rd 8.

\* 1 sc (the first sc of the rd will be a st-sc), 2 FLdc into the FL of the underlying FLtr in rd 6, sk 2 sc from rd 8, 1 sc, 1 inc, 2 FLdc into the FL of the underlying FLtr in rd 6, sk 2 sc from rd 8, 1 sc \* 6 times, slst in 1st sc.

Do not cut yarn.

(54 stitches)



#### Round 10

Complete round 10 of Mandala N°6 as written, BACK-LOOP ONLY.

#### Round 11

Change yarn to next color. Fasten on the new yarn in the 1st st of any inc (BL) of rd 10.

\*1 sc (the first sc of the round will be a st-sc), 2 FLdc in each FL of rd 8 which are visible between the FLdc of rd 9, sk 4 sts of rd 10\* 12 times, NJ in 1st sc.

(60 stitches)



#### Round 12

Change yarn to next color. Fasten on the new yarn in the 1st FLdc (BL) of any 4 FLdc of rd 11.

\*4 sc (the first sc of the rd will be a st-sc), 2 FPtr working these stitches around the underlying FLdc of rd 9, sk 1 st of rd 11\* 12 times, NJ in 1st sc.

(72 stitches)



#### Round 13

Change yarn to next color. Fasten on the new yarn in 1st of any 2 FPtr (BL) from rd 12.

Continue round 13 of Mandala N°6 as written.

(84 stitches)



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
