## Baby Henry's Designer Heirloom Afghan Crochet Along \{PART 3\}



In this part we will be working rounds 31 through 39 of Mandala $\mathrm{N}^{\circ} 6$.

## Resources

- Incorporated Designs: This blanket incorporates patterns by three amazing designers. They are all beautifully written patterns with great photo tutorials. You will need to purchase "Mandala $N^{\circ} 6^{\prime}$ " by CAROcreated, available on Ravelry or Etsy, and "Dandelion Border-Overlay Crochet" by Lilla Bjorn, also available on Ravelry or Etsy. "Sophie's Garden Squaring" by Dedri Uys is available on her website. To assemble this blanket, you will need these three patterns and the modifications released in this CAL.

## BEFORE YOU START:

1. If you have not already done so you will need to purchase Mandala $N^{\circ} 6^{\prime \prime}$ by CAROcreated.
2. READ the "Important Notes" section of the Mandala ${ }^{\circ}{ }^{\circ} 6$ Pattern on pages 5-7, this contains very useful and important information!
3. Note that all single stitches in this pattern should be worked BACK-LOOP ONLY unless otherwise noted.

## Instructions

## Rounds 1-30

Instructions are in the previous parts.
Round 31-35
Complete rounds 31-35 of Mandala $\mathrm{N}^{\circ} 6$ as written.
(216 stitches)

## Round 36

Change yarn to next color. Fasten on the new yarn to any FPtr (BL) of rd 35 which lies directly to the right of 15 sc.

* 1 sc (the first sc of the rd will be a st-sc), ${ }^{\phi} 1$ FPtr into the underlying FPtr in rd 33 sk 1 sc from rd $35,1 \mathrm{sc},{ }^{\phi}$ (repeat between ${ }^{\phi} 7$ times), 1 FPtr into the underlying FPtr in rd 33, sk 1 sc from rd 35, 2 sc * 12 times, NJ in 1st sc.


## (216 stitches)

## Round 37-39

Complete rounds 37-39 of Mandala ${ }^{\circ}$ 6 as written.

## (228 stitches)



## Round 40

Change yarn to next color. Fasten on the new yarn to any FPtr2tog (BL) of rd 39.

* 1 sc (the first sc of the rd will be a st-sc), 1 FPtr into the underlying FPtr in rd 36, sk 1 sc from rd 39, 7 sc, 1 FPtr into the underlying FPtr in rd 36, sk 1 sc from rd 39, 1 sc, 1 FPtr into the underlying FPtr in rd 36, sk 1 sc from rd 39, $6 \mathrm{sc}, 1$ FPtr into the underlying FPtr in rd 36, sk 1 sc from rd 39* 12 times, NJ in 1st sc.
(228 stitches)



## Round 41

Change yarn to next color. Fasten on the new yarn to the first sc of any 7 sc group.

* 8 sc (the first sc of the rd will be a st-sc), $1 \mathrm{inc}, 8 \mathrm{sc}$, FPdc around the underlying FPtr2tog in rd 39, sk 1 sc from rd 40, 1 sc* 12 times, NJ in 1st sc.
(240 stitches)



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
