

Baby Henry's Designer Heirloom Afghan Crochet Along {PART 5}



In this part, we will be making 5 rounds of straight **BACK LOOP ONLY** single crochet stitches. This is a good week to catch up if you are a bit behind.

Resources:

- **Incorporated Designs:** This blanket incorporates patterns by three amazing designers. They are all beautifully written patterns with great photo tutorials. **You will need to purchase** “Mandala N°6” by CAROcreated, available on [Ravelry](#) or [Etsy](#), and “Dandelion Border-Overlay Crochet” by Lilla Bjorn, also available on [Ravelry](#) or [Etsy](#). “Sophie’s Garden Squaring” by Dedri Uys is available on her [website](#). Materials:

You will need yarn, an appropriately sized crochet hook and a tapestry needle for joining. For more details on this see the introduction information.

53	Metal Grey-242	Dark Olive -387
54	Mercury-074	Ultramarine -124
55	Light Silver-172	Light Navy -164
56	Bridal White-105	Ultramarine -124
57	Champagne-248	Light Navy -164

Abbreviations:

This pattern uses US terms

ch	chain	NJ	needle join
sc	single crochet	st(s)	stitch(es)
BLsc	back loop single crochet	rd	round

BEFORE YOU START:

1. Note that all single stitches in this pattern should be worked **BACK-LOOP ONLY** unless otherwise noted.
2. The "hidden stitch" is the first stitch after each corner. If you are not familiar with this term Dedri has a great tutorial on her blog; [Look What I Made Tutorial](#).

Instructions:

Rounds 1-52

Instructions are in the previous parts.

Round 53

Change yarn to next color. Fasten on the new yarn to any sc (BL) of rd 52.

BLsc in each stitch across, (sc, ch1, sc) in corners, **DO NOT** skip hidden stitch.

(344 stitches and 4 ch-1 spaces, 86 stitches per side)

Round 54

Change yarn to next color. Fasten on the new yarn to any sc (BL) of rd 53.

BLsc in each stitch across, (sc, ch1, sc) in corners, **SKIP** the hidden stitch.

(348 stitches and 4 ch-1 spaces, 87 stitches per side)

Round 55

Change yarn to next color. Fasten on the new yarn to any sc (BL) of rd 54.

BLsc only in each stitch across, (sc, ch1, sc) in corners, **DO NOT** skip hidden stitch.

(356 stitches and 4 ch-1 spaces, 89 stitches per side)

Round 56

Change yarn to next color. Fasten on the new yarn to any sc (BL) of rd 55.

BLsc only in each stitch across, (sc, ch1, sc) in corners, **DO NOT** skip hidden stitch.

(364 stitches and 4 ch-1 spaces, 91 stitches per side)

Round 57

Change yarn to next color. Fasten on the new yarn to any sc (BL) of rd 56.

BLsc only in each stitch across, (sc, ch1, sc) in corners, **DO NOT** skip hidden stitch.

(372 stitches and 4 ch-1 spaces, 93 stitches per side)



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
