

Baby Henry's Designer Heirloom Afghan Crochet Along {PART 6}



In this part, we will be finishing the center square with the Dandelion border.

Resources

BEFORE YOU START:

1. If you have not already done so you will need to purchase "Dandelion Border-Overlay Crochet" by [Lilla Bjorn](#)
2. **READ the "Important Notes" section of the Dandelion Border-Overlay Crochet pattern on pages 3-5, this contains very useful and important information!**
3. Note that all single stitches in this pattern should be worked **BACK-LOOP ONLY** unless otherwise noted.

Instructions

Rounds 1-57

Instructions are in the previous parts.

Round 58

Complete **rd 9** of Dandelion Border as written, except that you will repeat [] 46 times instead of 39 times.

Note: Round 58 starts in a sc not hdc as in Dandelion pattern.

(380 stitches and 4 ch-1 spaces; 95 stitches per side {46 spiked sc and 49 sc})

Round 59

Complete **rd 10** of Dandelion Border as written, except that you will do 95 sc instead of 85 sc.

(388 stitches and 4 ch-1 spaces; 97 stitches per side)

Round 60-71

Complete **rds 11-22** of Dandelion Border as written, except that you will have one more repeat per side ON EACH ROUND.

Notes:

In round 61 (rd 12 of Dandelion pattern), the pattern says there will be 6 v's but we will have 7.

In round 71 (22 in pattern), if you are using a yarn with more give or stretch you may want to work the corner (1 sc, ch1, 1 sc) into the chain space instead of the BL of the ch1. Some testers found that there was some twisting of the corners in later parts without this modification.

| 62 | 13 | 412 stitches and 4 ch-1 spaces | 103 stitches |
| 63 | 14 | 424 stitches and 4 dtr | 106 stitches |
| 64 | 15 | 428 stitches and 4 ch-1 spaces | 107 stitches |
| 65 | 16 | 436 stitches and 4 ch-1 spaces | 109 stitches |
| 66 | 17 | 444 stitches and 4 ch-1 spaces | 111 stitches |
| 67 | 18 | 452 stitches and 4 ch-1 spaces | 113 stitches |
| 68 | 19 | 460 stitches and 4 ch-1 spaces | 115 stitches |
| 69 | 20 | 468 stitches and 4 ch-1 spaces | 117 stitches |
| 70 | 21 | 476 stitches and 4 ch-1 spaces | 119 stitches |
| 71 | 22 | 484 stitches and 4 ch-1 spaces | 121 stitches |
