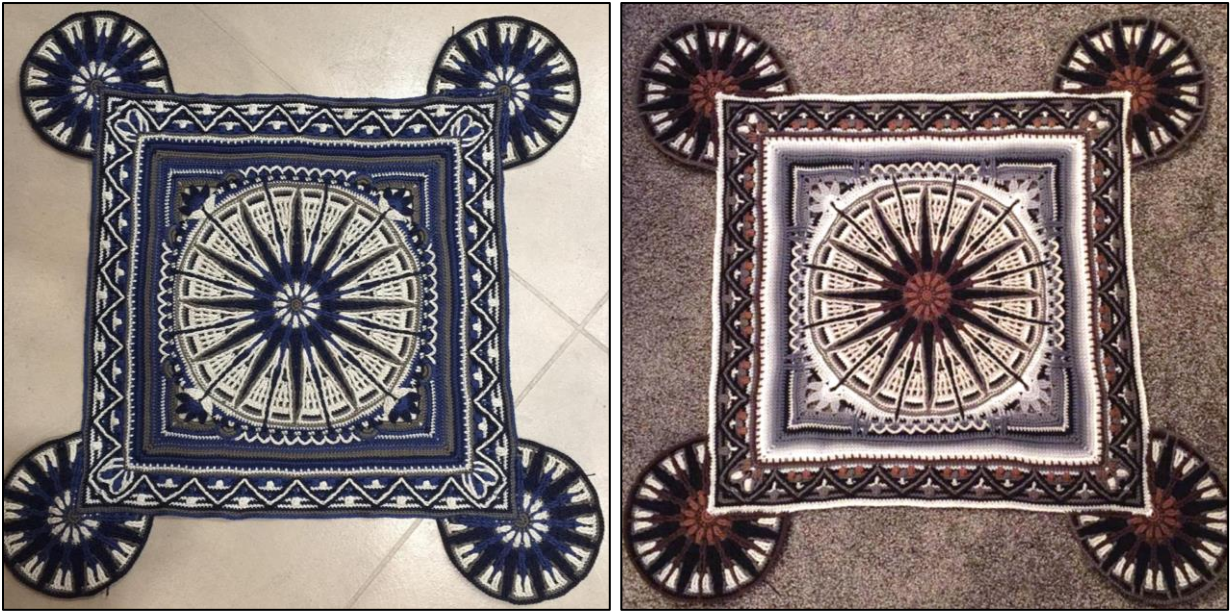


Baby Henry's Designer Heirloom Afghan Crochet Along {PART 8}



In this part, we will be continuing the partial corner mandalas.

Resources

- **Incorporated Designs:** This blanket incorporates patterns by three amazing designers. They are all beautifully written patterns with great photo tutorials. **You will need to purchase** “Mandala N°6” by CAROcreated, available on [Ravelry](#) or [Etsy](#), and “Dandelion Border-Overlay Crochet” by Lilla Bjorn, also available on [Ravelry](#) or [Etsy](#). “Sophie’s Garden Squaring” by Dedri Uys is available on her [website](#). To assemble this blanket, you will need these three patterns and the modifications released in this CAL.

You will need yarn, an appropriately sized crochet hook and a tapestry needle for joining. For more details on this see the introduction information.

Abbreviations

This pattern uses US terms

ch	chain	FPtr	front post treble crochet
sc	single crochet	FPdtr	front post double treble crochet
hdc	half double crochet	FLtr2Tog	front loop treble crochet 2 together
dc	double crochet	FPtr2tog	front post treble crochet 2 together
tr	treble crochet	inc	increase/increases
FL	front loop	ESS	end slip stitch
FP	front post	SSS	starting slip stitch
FLdc	front loop double crochet	st(s)	stitch(es)
FPdc	front post double crochet	sk	skip
FLtr	front loop treble crochet	rd	round

Special Stitches:

Ending Slip Stitch (ESS) – Remove the loop that is on your hook after the last stitch {left photo below}. Insert the hook, from the back, into both loops of the stitch from the round where you will be joining. Pull the loop through to the back. Cut the yarn leaving a tail for weaving in. Pull the tail through the loop {middle photo below}, and pull the tail to tighten the stitch a bit {right photo below} then weave in the ends. You can also watch the [video instructions here](#).



Starting Slip Stitch (SSS) – Insert hook into the indicated stitch in the round where you will be joining {left photo below}. Leaving a tail, pull through a loop of your new working yarn {middle photo below}, ch 1, {right photo below}. Pull the tail to tighten the stitch a bit. I recommend weaving in the ends as you go, either by crocheting over the tail as you complete the round or by another means shortly after completion of round. BEFORE YOU START:

1. Note that all single stitches in this pattern should be worked **BACK-LOOP ONLY** unless otherwise noted.
2. **For most rounds of the partial mandalas you will need both these instructions and the original pattern. You should read through both the original pattern and these instructions for the round before starting.**
3. I recommend watching [this video](#) that will provide a tutorial on how to do the beginning and end joining.
4. Rounds 85-94 will be repeated on each of the four partial corner mandalas.
5. Note that the joins will be rather visible at first. When all partial mandalas are completed we will be making a slip stitch round that will hide this and make it look much tidier.

Instructions

Rounds 1-84

Instructions are in the previous parts.

Round 85

Join yarn with a SSS (both loops) in the 14th stitch before the corner in rd 71.

During the first repeat skip 3 sts instead of the indicated 2 sts when making the first group of tr stitches.

2 sc, repeat from * to * of **rd 14** in the Mandala No. 6 pattern 9 times. Omit last st of final repeat.

(Hint: Last sc before each group, except the first repeat, will fall in the first st of the inc from the previous round.)

End with an ESS (both loops) in the 14th stitch after the corner in rd 71.

(73 stitches per mandala)

Round 86

Join yarn with a SSS (both loops) in the 15th stitch before the corner in rd 71.

1 FPtr around each FPtr from round 83, skip 2sts, 1 sc, repeat from * to * of **rd 15** in the Mandala No. 6 pattern 9 times. Omit last st of final repeat. Sk 1 st.

End with an ESS (both loops) in the 15th stitch after the corner in rd 71.

(74 stitches per mandala)

Round 87

Join yarn with a SSS (both loops) in the 16th stitch before the corner in rd 71.

Repeat from * to * of **rd 16** in the Mandala No. 6 pattern 9 times, 2 sc.

End with an ESS (both loops) in the 16th stitch after the corner in rd 71.

(83 stitches per mandala)

Round 88

Join yarn with a SSS (both loops) in the 17th stitch before the corner in rd 71.

3 sc, repeat from * to * of **rd 17** in the Mandala No. 6 pattern 9 times. Omit last st of final repeat.

End with an ESS (both loops) in the 17th stitch after the corner in rd 71.

(83 stitches per mandala)

Round 89

Join yarn with a SSS (both loops) in the 18th stitch before the corner in rd 71.

1 FPtr2tog - work the 1st FPtr of this FPtr2tog around the 1st of the two underlying FPtr or rd 86 and the 2nd FPtr of this FPtr2tog around the 2nd of the two underlying FPtr of rd 86 (sk 2 sts), 2 sc, repeat from * to * of **rd 18** in the Mandala No. 6 pattern 9 times. Omit last 2 sts of final repeat.

End with an ESS (both loops) in the 18th stitch after the corner in rd 71.

(382 stitches per mandala)

Round 90

Join yarn with a SSS (both loops) in the 19th stitch before the corner in rd 71.

Repeat from * to * of **rd 19** in the Mandala No. 6 pattern 9 times, 1 sc.

(Hint: The first sc will be in the first FPtr2tog.)

End with an ESS (both loops) in the 19th stitch after the corner in rd 71.

(82 stitches per mandala)

Round 91

Join yarn with a SSS (both loops) in the 20th stitch before the corner in rd 71.

3 sc, repeat from * to * of **rd 20** in the Mandala No. 6 pattern 9 times. Omit last 2 sts of final repeat.

End with an ESS (both loops) in the 20th stitch after the corner in rd 71.

(82 stitches per mandala)

Round 92

Join yarn with a SSS (both loops) in the 21st stitch before the corner in rd 71.

1 sc, [2 FLdtr] in the underlying st of rd 86 which lies directly to the left of the two FPtr of rd 86, (sk 2 sts), 1 sc, repeat from * to * of **rd 21** in the Mandala No. 6 pattern 9 times. Omit last 3 sts of final repeat.

End with an ESS (both loops) in the 21st stitch after the corner in rd 71.

(91 stitches per mandala)

Round 93

Join yarn with a SSS (both loops) in the 22nd stitch before the corner in rd 71.

During the first repeat omit the first 2 sts, repeat from * to * of **rd 22** in the Mandala No. 6 pattern 9 times, 3 sc.

End with an ESS (both loops) in the 22nd stitch after the corner in rd 71.

(100 stitches per mandala)

Round 94

Join yarn with a SSS (both loops) in the 23rd stitch before the corner in rd 71.

4 sc, repeat from * to * of **rd 23** in the Mandala No. 6 pattern 9 times. Omit last 3 sts of final repeat.

(Tip: You may wish to place stitch markers in the first and third sts to help in rd 100.)

End with an ESS (both loops) in the 23rd stitch after the corner in rd 71.

(100 stitches per mandala)



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
