

Friends Around the World 5rd Anniversary CAL 2020 Instructions for adding extra finishing rounds

The following instructions will prepare your squares for joining. All squares will need to be at a final count of 48 sts per side.

Once you finish your individual squares, you'll note that they will have various stitch counts so it will be necessary to add 3 additional rounds to bring the final count to 48 sts per side. Pay close attention as the instructions vary slightly based on the number of stitches in each square causing each Set of Rounds to have different instructions.

There will be separate documents for each different stitch count per square published on the Monday following the Thursday square release.

NOTE:

- if you will be using the same color for all 3 rounds you may slip stitch into the ch-sp and follow the instructions for the remainder of the round starting with "ch1".
- you may also use a Standing Single Crochet (hdc, dc) to start your round instead of the "ch1, sc".
- you may adjust the length of your stitches to half double crochet (hdc) or double crochet (dc) instead of the single crochet (sc) as stated in the instructions to achieve the same size in all squares.

US TERMS 3 Extra Rounds for squares ending with 42sts per side plus 1 stitch in corner

US Stitch Abbreviations

sc - single crochet ch-sp - chain space ch - chain slst - slip stitch st/sts - stitch/stitches

Round 1: Join in any corner stitch, ch1, *3sc in corner st/sp, sc in between squares, sc in ch3 sp across to corner* 4 times, slst to 1st sc, fasten off and weave in ends. (42 sts, 3sc in corner) per side

Round 2: Join in any corner ch-sp, ch1, *(sc, ch2, sc) in center corner stitch, sc in next 44 sts* 4 times, slst to 1st sc, fasten off and weave in ends. (46 sts, ch2) per side

Round 3: Join in any corner ch-sp, ch1, *(sc, ch2, sc) in corner ch-sp, sc in next 46 sts* 4 times, slst to 1st sc, fasten off and weave in ends. (48 sts, ch2) per side



NOTE:

- if you will be using the same color for all 3 rounds you may slip stitch into the ch-sp and follow the instructions for the remainder of the round starting with "ch1".
- you may also use a Standing Double Crochet (htr, tr) to start your round instead of the "ch1, dc".
- you may adjust the length of your stitches to half treble crochet (htr) or treble crochet (tr) instead of the double crochet (dc) as stated in the instructions to achieve the same size in all squares.

UK TERMS 3 Extra Rounds for squares ending with 42sts per side plus 1 stitch in corner

UK Stitch Abbreviations dc – double crochet ch-sp – chain space ch – chain slst – slip stitch st/sts – stitch/stitches

Round 1: Join in any corner ch-sp, ch1, *3dc in corner st/sp, dc in between squares, dc into ch3 sp across to corner* 4 times, slst to 1st dc, fasten off and weave in ends. (42 sts, 3dc in corner) per side

Round 2: Join in any corner ch-sp, ch1, *(dc, ch2, dc) in center corner stitch, dc in next 44 sts* 4 times, slst to 1st dc, fasten off and weave in ends. (46 sts, ch2) per side

Round 3: Join in any corner ch-sp, ch1, *(dc, ch2, dc) in corner ch-sp, dc in next 46 sts* 4 times, slst to 1st dc, fasten off and weave in ends. (48 sts, ch2) per side
